Guest Information

Reservations: Advance slip reservations are required and may be arranged via phone or email. If you arrive without a reservation we cannot guarantee you a place.

Location: Past Devil's Reach, one last curve of the Chester River brings Chestertown and her bascule bridge into the forward line of sight. CRY&CC is located just south and west of the nun "40" channel marker on this approach.

Dockmaster: Dick Swanson or his appointee will be available to assist with your arrival, docking, registration and orientation with advance reservations.

Fees: \$2.00 per foot plus \$8 for 30 amps and \$10 for 50 amp power hookup (per night) will be accessed upon arrival. Checks, cash, and credit card will be received in the Golf Pro Shop located across the street at the left end of the main building.

Accommodations: Slip and mooring availability may accommodate small-drafted 18 foot vessels to large-drafted 50+ foot vessels. Catering to cruisers, the Club's staff is ready to assist with tee times and golf club rentals, cocktails, and meal service. Cruisers often prefer a more casual meal in the Club bar or on the patio. On Friday late afternoon, cruisers especially enjoy a dip in the pool, a drink at the dockside Happy Hour, and then a prime rib dinner under the stars on the Club patio or at the pool. The Dock Bar is also open on Wednesday evenings.

Dining Room Dress: Casual but tasteful dress is requested. Jeans, shorts, or bathing suits are not permitted in the main dining areas. However, shorts (but no hats) are permitted in the Bar.

Washrooms: The entrance to the washrooms is located at the rear of the clubhouse near the Pro Shop and golf cart shed. An alternate entrance is located in the Bar. Restrooms and showers are also available just outside the pool.

Trash: Please dispose of all trash in the waterfront dumpster.

Swimming: Swimming is not permitted around and from the docks at the Yacht Club. The club swimming pool is available for use at no extra cost. Please pick up passes at the ProShop.

Food & Beverage: Picnic tables are available under the boathouse. Use of the Club's grills is not permitted. Private food and beverages are allowed on the boats and docks only. ICE is available for a fee from the bar inside the Clubhouse.

Clubhouse Patio and Pool Areas: Private food or beverages for adults are not permitted.

Fishing: Fishing is not permitted in the marina area.

Pets: Dogs will be walked on lead, in the grass, on the up-river side of the marina. Clean up bags may be deposited in the dumpster.

Conduct: Respectful appreciation to the membership, the staff, and the property is required of all guests of this private club. In return, guests will be welcomed back to this unique cruising destination.

Dock Rules: General rules are available online and are posted at the waterfront.

Excursions: Historic Chestertown is a short dinghy ride by water or a less than two-mile walk or bike ride by road. There are two taxi companies available, but require advanced notice of one hour. Angel Wings: 443-822-8309 and Key Lime Taxi: 410-996-4950 x 2.

Chandlery and Fuel: The Chestertown Marina, less than a nautical mile on the portside of the river, offers ship's store items, fuel and pump-out. The Marina is currently under renovation. Chestertown Marina may have closures during renovations. Rolph's Wharf, one mile down river from the Club has fuel and chandlery.

Club Hours: The Clubhouse is closed on Mondays only. Call Tuesday through Sunday to make all reservations and to inquire about weekend specials and events.

Exclusions: There are no reciprocal rates available for use of the golf course unless you are a member of a PGA Club and arrangements have been made through your Golf Professional prior to your visit with us. An unaccompanied guest fee may be paid for play as long as arrangements are made through our Golf Professional prior to your arrival.
